Kenneth Leech was a committed Christian Socialist who drew on the historical precedents of the radical Anglo-Catholic tradition. He was a priest, a prophet and a theologian who was rooted in and resourced by a sacramental spirituality, and greatly inspired by Thomas Merton. He was a regular lecturer at universities in the UK and the USA and produced many books of theology and spirituality. His books were practical and grounded in his work and ministry in the East End of London. He was essentially a theologian of the streets.
